During the internship you will learn:

Project Management skills (PRIMARY):

- 1. Assist in managing exciting "Digital for Development¹" projects
- 2. Update an online platform with best practices on development projects in Africa and elsewhere who best use digital skills to create social impact
- 3. Help coordinate and organize project events (such as networking & cocreation events, hackathon, mission in Africa)
- 4. Getting to know the main actors in development in Belgium (Government, civil society and private sector companies)
- 5. Working with Close the Gap various partners and expanding your network and communication skills.

Communications & Social Media Management skills (SECONDARY²):

6. Together with the Communications team, create and implement long term social media strategy, plan and marketing calendar to grow Close the Gap and WorldLoop's online social networks and visibility.

¹ One of these projects is: First of its kind Belgian Digital for Development platform, initiated by the Belgian Development cooperation (DGD), launched in September 2017, and coordinated by Agoria and Close the Gap. Its focus is to bring all actors of development together, creating a knowledge-sharing eco-system on projects and opportunities using digital in development, to ultimately stimulate the Belgian private sector engagement in the development sector.

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- 7. Relationship building with Close the Gap's online community by updating, maintaining and responding to Facebook, Twitter, LinkedIn, and other media accounts to bring value to those user's interactions with Close the Gap and WorldLoop.
- 8. How to track social media analytics using Google Analytics and other software, and report results and new ideas to the entire team.
- 9. Work with the team to research articles, stories and resources relevant to our stakeholders, and create compelling content that will be shared by influencers.

The ideal candidate has several of the following qualities:

- Background in Commercial Engineering, Business, Marketing, Communication, non-profit management or other related discipline.
- Creative self-starter who is comfortable with both multi-tasking and taking initiative. You are also comfortable with working independently as well as in collaboration team.
